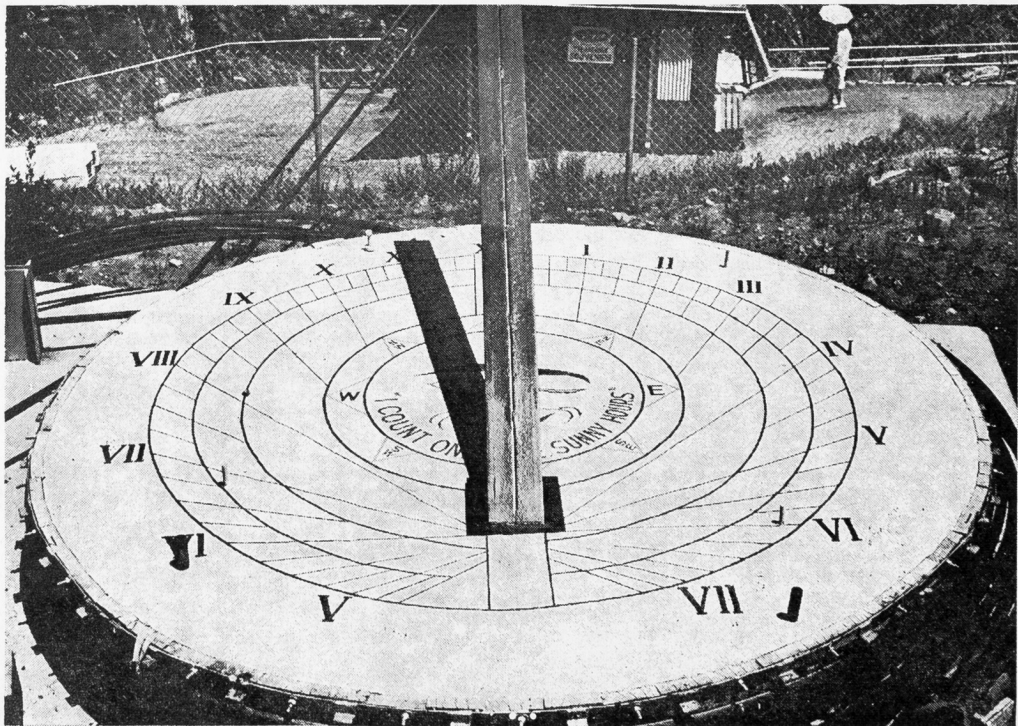


COLORADO'S LARGEST TIMEPIECE
