The Beginning

- Natural Sandstone
 Díal Face
 - Approx 20" wide and 18 " high
 - Gnomon is #4 Copper Wire
 - Díal Reference Lines
 Visible on either side
 of gnomon will
 become the 6 AM and
 6 PM time lines



Desert Varnísh

- Díal face is chemically treated to mimic a natural Desert Varnish surface.
- The process used on this stone will produce the desired result in 8-16 weeks. This photo taken at about 4 weeks into the process
- Natural Desert Varnish takes 1000-2500 years or more to produce the shiny black surface seen on most Petroglyph panels in the Southwest.



- Díal línes and my
 "Maker's Mark" are
 Hand-carved by
 removing the rock
 surface and the Desert
 Varnísh by incising,
 pecking, carving, and
 abrading with a harder
 stone "tool" (Basalt
 found in the Santa Clara
 River of SW Utah was
 used on this dial).
- Díal Numerals and Motto are sandblasted to preserve the necessary detail for the Dial function



- The oldest petroglyphs are dated to approximately the Neolithic and late upper Paleolithic boundary, about 10,000 to 12,000 years ago,
- Petroglyphs represent a convergence of art, communications and science.
- A sun díal ís also an art form, a communications device, a timepiece, and finally, a demonstration of a dialist's knowledge of the science and, proper expression of time.



- As with the Ancient Petroglyphs so common in the American Southwest. It is the Desert Varnish on the rock surface that makes the carved images so vivid.
- Natural Desert Varnísh takes 1000's of years to accumulate through natural chemical and biological processes
- The Sun Stone process provides a remarkably close facsimile, without resorting to the quarrying and ultimate loss of this irreplaceable source of natural beauty.
