## Come To St. Louis For The 23rd Annual NASS Conference! August 19-22, 2017

The conference will be held at the Clayton Plaza Hotel, 7750 Carondelet Ave., Clayton, Missouri 63105. A number of rooms have been set aside at a discounted rate of \$119/night (plus16%tax). This rate will also apply 3 days before and after the conference if rooms are available. A complimentary full breakfast buffet is included each day. Rooms come with complimentary WiFi, fridge, microwave, and coffeemaker. The hotel is located 9 miles from the Lambert St Louis International Airport (hotel has a free shuttle), and three blocks from the Clayton Metro Link. For those who drive, parking fees are \$6/night. We are planning some tutorial sessions (*a new feature!*) for the afternoon of Saturday Aug.  $19^{\text{th}}$ . Our registration event with light refreshments, short stories, and an array of door prizes will take place from 4:30-6:30pm on Saturday. The conference talks will be on Sunday the 20th and Tuesday morning the 22nd. Our bus tour on Monday the  $21^{\text{st}}$  will include the Missouri Botanical Gardens (with a number of dials), the historic Cahokia Mounds, a possible new dial dedication, and a viewing of the **Total Solar Eclipse**.

[Please note that our bus seats 56. We are investigating options, but we do not think we will be able to include more than 56 people on the tour. So registration will be limited to the first 56 people to send in their form and fee. This year each person who registers will receive a confirmation as soon as your form and check arrive – that way you will be certain that one of the coveted bus seats is indeed reserved for you!]

The conference runs through 1:00pm on Tuesday; please plan to stay for the entire agenda. Our schedule this year includes the usual range of talks.
